

# Circle A Round

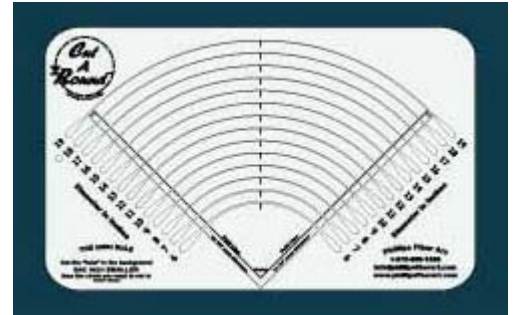

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## Class Supply List

Quilt size without outside borders 40 X 32"

You will need the Circle A Round book by Cheryl Phillips (available on line at: [www.phillipsfiberart.com](http://www.phillipsfiberart.com)). You will also need the "Cut A Round" ruler standard for circles 6" through 17".



### Supplies needed for the class:

- Machine needles: I used a 75/11
- Machine Feet: ¼ inch quilting foot, Curve Master Presser foot (Optional), walking foot.
- Threads: regular neutral sewing thread for constructing the quilt top, and bobbins.
- Chalk pencil or chalk marker or other marking pen in a color that will show up on your fabric.
- Rotary cutter (45mm) and mat with long ruler.
- Scissors and pins.
- Heavy-duty spray starch or sizing to stabilize fabric. To save time in class please have your material pre-washed and starched before you get to class.
- **Your sewing machine, knee lift, foot pedal, electric cord and sewing table if you have one.**

### Fabric needed for quilt:

- 1 ¼ yard for the background fabric and binding (if you want to make the quilt larger, measure the area you want to cover and purchase enough fabric to cover that area, it can be pieced)
- 1 yard for the quilt back
- 1- 45 X 36" piece of batting
- 4 Fat Quarters or scraps for the different circles. The largest circle piece will need to be 20", and then they can come down an inch in size for every one after that. If you are making the quilt bigger you may want more than 4 FQ's to cover the entire area of your quilt top.
- ½ yard for the stripe and 1 more circle. You may need more if you plan to make the quilt larger.

You can always add borders to the top and sides to make the quilt larger, and then you would need fabric for the borders. I suggest that you use some of the same fabrics as you selected for the circles if you plan to do this.
